CRJC 429 - Internship and Career Preparation in Criminal Justice

Credit Hours: 3 Lecture Hours: 3 Lab Hours: 0

This course familiarizes students with issues related to internship and career preparation in the field of criminal justice. Students will learn about issues related to the criminal justice internship experience, such as finding an internship, preparing for the internship interview, and professional and ethical conduct in the criminal justice internship setting. Students will explore a wide range of careers in criminal justice and learn information regarding processes involved in successfully pursuing and advancing in careers in criminal justice. Successful completion of this course is a prerequisite for enrolling in <u>CRJC</u> 430, Internship in Criminal Justice.
