



I've completed my 2020-2021 FAFSA®. What are my next steps?

Once a FAFSA is submitted, the US Department of Education processes the application and determines if a student is selected for verification.

Verification is the process we use to confirm that the data reported on your FAFSA application is accurate. If you're selected for verification, we will request additional documentation that supports the information you reported. If selected, submit any requested documentation as soon as possible. Your verification must be completed before you can receive a financial aid offer.



If the application is **Selected** for verification, the student/parent must complete the process before an offer is given.

Students and families will be required to submit documentation to affirm the household, tax, and income information listed on the FAFSA application.

- The required forms will be listed on your Banner Self-Service.
- Our office will also send you a list of forms that must be submitted.
