Developed by educators for educators, edTPA (Teacher Performance Assessment) is an assessment in the form of an electronic portfolio designed by SCALE to assess if a teacher-candidate is ready to teach students in a classroom. It is intended to be used for teacher licensure, to support state and national program accreditation, and to support program renewal. edTPA is a true cycle of the planning, instruction, and assessment

The edTPA portfolio will be completed and submitted during the teacher candidates' student teaching (Clinical Experience) semester. This assessment will be required for a NC teaching license beginning in the Fall of 2019. Teacher Candidates will take part in various workshops and informational sessions as support during the process along with their University Supervisors (EPP's) and Cooperating Teachers in the school systems.
