- 3.1. **Core Critical Thinking.** PHIL 110 Or PHIL 220 . Not required for students with 60+ transfer credits. Students do not earn credit if requirement is waived.
- 3.2. **Core Quantitative Reason.** MATH 123 . MATH 121 may be required based on profile scores. Some core courses require a one-hour lab.

- 9.12. **Mgmt Info Systems.** MIS 212 And MIS 320 And MIS 321 And MIS 330 And MIS 331 And select three (or 9 credit hours) from MIS 300-449 .
- 9.13. **Other Program.** Select two (6 credit hours) from: ACCT Or BADM Or ENTR Or FINC Or HCM Or MGMT Or MIS Or MKTG at the 300-400 level .
