- 1.1.** **Core Transitional UNIV.** (UNIV 101 And UNIV 102) Or UNIV 110 Or UNIV 111 . UNIV 101-UNIV 102 required for all first time students; UNIV 110 required for transfer students with fewer than 30 transfer credits. Students do not earn credit if requirement is waived. UNIV 111 may be required based on academic performance.

  - 3.1.** **Core Critical Thinking.** PHIL 110 Or PHIL 220 . Not required for students with 60+ transfer credits. Students do not earn credit if requirement is waived.
  - 3.2.** **Core Quantitative Reason.** MATH 123 . MATH 121 may be required based on profile scores. Some core courses require a one-hour lab.
  - 4.** **Core Info Literacy.** ENGL 120 .
  - 5.1.** **Core Natural Sci.** NSCI 110 Or NSCI 111 And NSCI 111L And NSCI 120 .
  - 5.2.** **Core Social Sci.** POLI 210 Or POLI 220 Or SOCI 210 .
  - 6.** **Core Humn Creative Arts.** HUMN 211 Or HUMN 212 .
  - 7.** **Core Global Literacy.** HIST 110 Or HIST 120 . Not required for students with 30+ transfer credits from a foreign institution. Students do not earn credit if requirement is waived.
