## **Timely Warning Notification – 02-13-2023**

Reported Crime: Possession of a Firearm on Educational Property

Location: Outdoor Basketball Courts/ Capel Arena; 1200 Murchison Rd.

Notice is being provided to the campus community of an alleged crime reported to have occurred on the Fayetteville State University Campus. We are sending this message for you:

- •To protect yourself and others in our community
- •To notify you that there may be a threat to the campus or near the campus
- •To help with the investigation of possible crimes

On February 13, 2023, at approximately 6:50pm, two unknown male subjects were involved in an altercation on the outdoor basketball courts near Capel Arena. During the altercation a third male suspect was observed going into a backpack and pulling what is described as a dark in color firearm and waving it in the air. The two males fighting along with the suspect who brandished the suspected firearm fled the courts. The suspect left the courts walking toward Slater Avenue off campus. His last known location was crossing Langdon St traveling North off campus.

Suspect Information: Suspect is a Black Male with dreads wearing a blue hoodie. The suspect is in possession of a pink and black backpack which contains a possible firearm.

The Fayetteville State University Police Department is currently investigating this incident.
